The Board of Ellis County Commissioners met in special session for the road tour at 8:04 a.m., Monday, April 26, 2021, at the Administration Center, 718 Main Street, Hays, Kansas.

Chair Robert "Butch" Schlyer called the special session on the road tour to order. Commissioners present: Chair Robert "Butch" Schlyer and Commissioner Neal Younger. Also present were County Administrator Darin Myers, Public Works Director Brendan Mackay and Road Supervisor Curt Hoffman.

The following roads were traveled and viewed during the Road Tour:

Ellis Avenue: Road and Bridge were given permission to move forward with turning the final approximate five miles of Ellis Avenue from blacktop to a sand/gravel/rock road. It was stated that this will not be able to happen right away, and it will take a couple of years to complete by only doing a mile or two a year.

12<sup>th</sup> Street and Rome Road: The Commission gave approval to proceed with the KLBP application to list the 12<sup>th</sup> Street and Rome Road bridge to close.

Fairground Road and 220<sup>th</sup>: The commission gave approval to correct the draining issues by adding ditches in the area of Fairground Road and 220<sup>th</sup> Ave.

The Commission asked MacKay to look into purchasing a tree cutting implement to cut down trees in the rights-of-way.

The Commission asked the Myers to look into creating a bridge fund for 2022. It would start with one (1) mill funding, which in turn would increase the county mill levy by one mill.

It was asked of the Commission from the Public Works' department to write a letter to a resident in Antonino who sells vehicles and parks them too close to the road.

No formal action was taken during the road tour and the meeting adjourned at 3:07 p.m.
