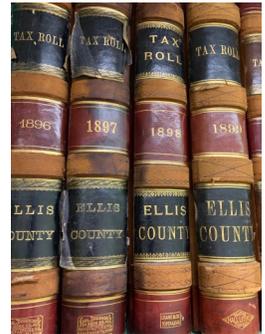
BENEFITS TO CITIZENS

BANKING: A few months after taking office and examining Ellis County's investment potential, I put out a bid for a more competitive banking agreement. It had been decades since this process had occurred. After a year-and-a-half on the job, the financial boost to County's bottom line has been substantial. My Fall 2018 newsletter outlined other specifics, but in summary, the new relationship with the winning bank, Astra, has yielded a "fee-free" management of County accounts, saving tens of thousands of dollars already. Further, the interest rate mirrors Federal Treasury rates, which have hovered right around 2.5% for the past year. Interest income alone for 2019 amounts to over \$200,000. This extra income comes at a time it is greatly needed as budgetary challenges are one of the main issues in our County.

TAX COLLECTION: In a combined effort with the County Commissioners and County Counselor, I have restructured the delinquent tax collection process.

New collection practices include annual Tax Sales, stop codes on vehicle renewals, and active communication with oil companies regarding garnishments. These practices amount to almost \$500,000 annually that had not been actively collected in the past.

PROCUREMENT: I enjoy negotiating and making sound financial decisions for the varying contracts the Treasury manages, ranging from banking contracts to postage machine contracts and everything in between. The courage and knowledge it takes to investigate which competitor is the best for Ellis County is something I enjoy doing as a lifelong learner and will continue to do as your Treasurer.

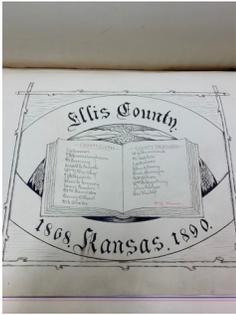
